8.0 CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

The Chair provided the following highlights from his report:

- The recent OACAS Board Presidents Webinar discussed renewing the provincial governance survey. The governors expressed strong support for a refined governance survey that has equity and accountability embedded into it. An important discussion also occurred with respect to wellness, culture and support for staff, children youth and families during the pandemic.
- The Catholic Children's Aid Society of Hamilton has paved the way to find synergies with the Catholic Family Services in Hamilton to better serve children, youth and families. This partnership has been hindered temporarily due to pandemic pressures on the Catholic Family Services organisation.

9.0 REPORT OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

The Executive Director spoke to the CTV *The Fifth Estate* story regarding the death of a youth-in-care at an outside paid resource home in Barrie that aired on Feb. 17,

2021. The board engaged in a discussion about this tragic situation and was informed about the issues impacting child welfare with respect to outside paid resources. This item will be brought forward to the next board meeting for further discussion.

The Executive Director provided the following highlights from his report:

- Statistics on service recipients for First Nation, Metis and Inuit (Indigenous) and Black persons will be brought forward to the March board meeting showing agency progress in these areas.
- 2018-2023 CCASH Strategic Plan The agency will engage in a review of the plan to ensure its relevance to present business requirements. The board will be engaged for their participation in the process.

10.1 Acknowledgement

The Governance Committee Chair stated the draft of the *Acknowledgement* to the Indigenous Community was prepared by the agency's Reconciliation Lead, and explained this document is to acknowledge the role that the child welfare sector has played in the 60's Scoop, Residential Schools, and ongoing removal of First Nations, Métis and Inuit children from their families. It was noted this will be a live document that will be informed over time by the community, its stakeholders and data collection.

After thorough discussion, the Governance Committee was tasked to review the document once more through the lens of provided feedback and bring forth the draft *Acknowledgement* to the March board meeting for review and finalizing.

10.2 Equity Statement

It was noted the *Equity Statement* is a live document that will be informed over time by the community, its stakeholders and data collection. After thorough discussion, the Governance Committee was tasked with a final review of the copy noted from feedback and bring forth a final version to the March board meeting.
