Bursary Eligibility

The Catholic Children's Aid Society of Hamilton (CCASH) along with support from our committed donors, proudly provides a number of bursaries designed to uplift and enrich the life trajectories of individuals we serve.

- Current and former wards
- Kin families
- Children and parents receiving services from the agency
- Children in families that foster children through CCASH (maximum of one bursary)

Bursary awards support any activities that are considered life-enhancing, such as:

- Ongoing education and skills training
- Employment outcomes and possibilities (specialized equipment purchase, computer and electronic purchase, ongoing training)

Application Review Process

Applications are reviewed by a team of CCASH staff who bring a range of perspectives to the review process. Your worker will not be on the review team, but the team will consult with your worker and other agency staff as needed, to gain a more complete picture of your application. The review team will consider and compare the following aspects of each application when making its decisions:

- Eligibility of the applicant and the proposed life-enhancing activity
- Completeness of the application
- Demonstrated ability to set and meet goals
- Financial need

Successful Applicants

Funding decisions are made and communicated to applicants in May, and the Scholarship is awarded at our Annual General Meeting in June. If successful, you will be contacted with all necessary details and asked to provide a video or photo testimonial thanking donors for their contributions.

Disbursement of funds will be directed toward tuition at your selected post-secondary institution, or distributed as a reimbursement for supplies (ie: books, laptop, etc.) with proof of purchase. You can discuss the disbursement of funds further with your worker.

Reapplying

You can reapply next year for another bursary to support multi-year activities, or to support a new life-enhancing activity.
